

Congratulations on your child's high school recommendation to register for a University course as a Community Scholar to pursue advanced study. It is recommended that you and your child engage in discussions regarding course expectations and responsibilities and we request that you review the following important relevant information.

1. High school students are not automatically approved to take courses as a Community Scholar. Student credential files, which include transcripts and recommendation letters, must be received and approved by the Community Scholar Program Director prior to registration.
2. High school students registering in a University credit course as a Community Scholar must comply with all University rules and regulations, including the Honor System, conduct code, as well as course requirements and procedures cited in the Undergraduate Record.
3. The University of Virginia will create a record in the name of your student. The grade he/she earns becomes a permanent part of his/her academic record. A University academic transcript for this course will follow your student in all future higher education endeavors (see [www.virginia.edu/registrar](http://www.virginia.edu/registrar) for more information).
4. High school students enrolling in University courses as a Community Scholar have an obligation to conduct themselves in a manner that is civil and compatible with the University's function as an educational institution. In a community of learning, willful disruption of the educational process, destruction of property, interference with the orderly process of the University, or with the rights of others cannot be tolerated. In order to fulfill its functions for imparting and gaining knowledge, the University has the authority and responsibility to maintain order within the University. The Dean of the School of Continuing and Professional Studies has the authority to exclude those who are disruptive of the educational process, including those whose behavior would present a threat to the health and safety of others.
5. Drops or withdrawals after the course has begun will carry a financial penalty based upon the school week within which the drop/withdrawal occurs (see [www.scps.virginia.edu/register-for-a-class/drop-refund-request](http://www.scps.virginia.edu/register-for-a-class/drop-refund-request) for more information).
